Day 1, Monday, July 17, 2023:

Depart the US on an overnight flight to Athens, Greece.

Day 2, Tuesday, July 18, 2023: Athens

We arrive in Athens where we are met by our representative who will assist us through customs and security. Drive to hotel for check-in.

Tonight, the “Prophetic Conference and Tour”, opens with a welcome dinner and an overview of where we will go and what we will experience during the next several days.

Day 3, Wednesday, July 19, 2023: Athens

In the morning we visit the Acropolis of Athens with its temples like the Parthenon or the Erechtheum and the Propylaea. Then we will ascend the hill of Filiopapos- “And then Paul settled in the Areopagus and gave his message”, Houses of Parliament, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and the Presidential Palace. As well as the stadium where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were celebrated.

Rest if the day at leisure.

Day 4, Thursday, July 20, 2023: Athens-Corinth

Leave the coastal road to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive on to Corinth, “And then Paul left Athens and went to Corinth...” From the Bema preached to the Corinthians and here Paul lived for 18 months. Drive on and visit ancient Corinth. Return to Athens.

Day 5, Friday, July 21, 2023: Athens-Israel

Welcome to the land of Israel for your Holy Land tour, on arrival at Ben Gurion International Airport, a representative will meet and assist us through customs and security. Transfer to the hotel in Tel-Aviv, Israel’s largest and most modern city which is just a short distance to Jaffa. Check-in to the hotel. Free day to sightsee.

Day 6, Saturday, July 22, 2023:

Our first stop is the ancient port of **Old Jaffa**, believed to be the oldest port in the world, with views of historic landmarks including **St. Peter's Church** (Mark 1:29) and the **House of Simon the Tanner** (Act 10:1–23). After, head up the coast along the Mediterranean Sea and visit **Caesarea** (Acts 9 & 25) Here we view the Roman ruins including the Roman Theater and aqueduct. Next, we stop at **Mt. Carmel** (I Kings 18) and view the great Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16:16). Then it's on our way to **Megiddo** (I Kings 9:15), **Nazareth** (Luke 1 & 2), passing by **Cana** (John 2), on our way to Tiberias (John 6:23). Check-in to our Kibbutz (hotel), rest/refresh, enjoy dinner looking out over the peaceful Sea of Galilee waters.

Day 7, Sunday, July 23, 2023:

After breakfast, we drive to the Dead Sea region, Visit **Qumran**, the administrative center of an Ascetic Jewish community that flourished between the 2nd century BC and the 1st century AD. Many scholars associate John the Baptist with this community and Jesus may have even spent time here. The community members were mostly scribes responsible for the copying and preservation of the Dead Sea Scrolls, Masada's archaeological remains bring alive its 70-70 CE inhabitants' intriguing tale. A symbol of steadfast strength to preserve national and religious identity and homeland, **Masada** is so replete with history that Israel invests in it as an official national park, and UNESCO declared it a World Heritage Site in 2001. Ascend by cable car up to the summit. Stop for overview at **Ein Gedi**, where David hid in a cave when running from Saul (1 Samuel 23) and may have composed several of his Psalms. One of the most unique experiences the Dead Sea has to offer is **floating in the Dead Sea!**

Day 8, Monday, July 24, 2023:

After breakfast, we visit **Yad Vashem**, Israel's national memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, spend time at the Museum with its Hall of Names, the Children's Memorial and Walk along the Street of the Righteous where Oscar Schindler and many others are memorialized.

Continue to the **Israel Museum** and visit the Shrine of the Book, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are housed. Visit the **model of Second Temple Jerusalem** to view Jerusalem as it looked during the time of Jesus. Drive by the Israeli parliament and the **Knesset Menorah**, our final stop will be at the **Friends of Zion Heritage Center** which brings the stories of Christian love for Israel to life in a unique multimedia and interactive way

Afternoon: Prophetic Conference at the Hotel

Dinner together followed by Prophetic Conference programming.

Day 9, Tuesday, July 25, 2023:

After breakfast, we will enjoy a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem from the crest of **Mt. of Olives** (Matthew 24:3). Walk along **Palm Sunday Road**, 'Hosanna to the son of David. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord (Luke 19:41-44). Stop at **Dominus Flevit** marking the spot where Jesus wept over the impending destruction of Jerusalem. (Luke 19:37-42)

Arrive at **Gethsemane** to visit the Church of All Nations that stands on the Rock of Agony where Jesus was betrayed by Judas (Matthew 26:36-57). Drive to **Mt. Zion** to visit the Church of **St. Peter in Gallicantu** meaning "cock's-crow" commemorating Peter's triple rejection of Jesus"... before the cock crows twice." (Mark 14:30). Also, on Mt. Zion, is the **Room of the Last Supper** also known as the Upper Room" in which Jesus shared the Last Supper with the disciples. (Luke 22:14-20) It is located directly above the **Tomb of David**. Walk in the Old City to the **Jewish Quarter** which is one of the four quarters of the walled city. **The Western Wall** "Wailing Wall", is the most religious site in the world for the Jewish people. Located in the Old City, it is the western support wall of the Temple Mount. Prayers are either spoken or written down and placed in the cracks of the wall. From there we will descend underground to the Western Wall Tunnels. The tunnels run along approximately 1600 feet of the Western Wall, giving visitors a taste of the challenge that stood before



Herod the Great during this immense building projects.

Afternoon: Prophetic Conference at the Hotel

Dinner together followed by Prophetic Conference programming.

Day 10, Wednesday, July 26, 2023:

Today we retrace the ministry of Christ that will include many biblical sites along Galilee's shores and in the Upper Jordan Valley: **Capernaum** (Matt. 4:13), **Mount of Beatitudes** (Matt. 5-7), Tabgha (Feeding of the 5,000, Mark 6), and Magdala (Matt. 15:39). An unforgettable time of worship will take place on the peaceful waters of the Sea of Galilee in a replica of a first-century fishing boat. We then travel north past Hazor (Josh 11:10, I Kings 9:15), to **Caesarea Philippi** (Panaes, Mark 8:27), and the eastern Golan Heights.

Dinner together followed by Prophetic Conference programming.

Day 11, Thursday, July 27, 2023:

Enter the Christian Quarter of the Old City via the Lion's Gate and walk along the Via Dolorosa, also known as the Station of the Cross, which is the route that Jesus walked from the prison to the crucifixion. Along the way we will visit the Judgement Hall of Pilate and the **Pool of Bethesda**. Take time for reflection at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Walk through the historic Christian & Jewish quarters of the Old City.

Dinner together followed by Prophetic Conference programming.

Day 12, Friday, July 28, 2023:

Visit the baptismal site of Yardenit, the site on the **River Jordan**, where it is believed that the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist took place. Enjoy travelling in the Beit She'an Valley and visit the archaeological site of **Beit Shean**, which is now protected as an Israeli National Park. Drive through the Jordanian Valley. *Dinner together followed by Prophetic Conference programming.*

Day 13, Saturday, July 29, 2023:

Free time at the Old City market
Conference Programming

Day 14, Sunday, July 30, 2023:

Drive to ben Gurion Airport for your flight back home
Arrive back to the US
